

Course Rules for Teenagers

The course rules apply throughout the entire course duration and are part of our Terms and Conditions. Please read them carefully with your parents. A detailed explanation will follow on the first day of the course.

1. Active Course Participation

- All students must actively participate in classes, meals, scheduled activities, and excursions.
- Mobile phones and other devices must be turned off during classes and activities. Long-term students aiming to attend school in Germany hand in their electronic devices overnight.
- Leaving the school premises is only allowed on designated days in groups of three without supervision. Students must sign out in a book when leaving and sign in when returning.

2. Respectful Behavior

- Students must behave in a way that does not disturb other students (e.g., no loud noise, untidiness).
- Intercultural differences should be respected.
- Instructions from staff must be followed by all students, including those who are 18 years old or older.

3. Order and Cleanliness

- Students are responsible for keeping their rooms tidy.
- · Tables must be cleared after meals.
- Cooking, electric kettles and eating in rooms are not allowed.

4. Damage

- Any damage to school property must be reported and replaced.
- Triggering smoke detectors that are directly connected to the fire department may result in a fine of approximately € 1,500 for the person responsible.

5. Prohibited Items, Alcohol, and Drugs

- Weapons, violent movies or games are not allowed.
- The possession or consumption of alcohol and drugs (including cannabis) are strictly prohibited on school premises.
- Outside the school premises, German law applies (no alcohol under 16 years old).
- Distributing alcohol to students under 16 may result in an immediate expulsion.

6. Smoking

- Smoking is only allowed in the designated smoking area outside the school building.
- Smoking inside the building or on balconies can lead to immediate expulsion.

7. Bedtime

- Sunday to Thursday: Room time is at 10:30 PM, and bedtime is at 11:00 PM.
- Friday and Saturday: Room time is at 11:30 PM, and bedtime is at midnight.

8. Dangerous Behavior

• Climbing on balconies, out of windows, or on roofs is strictly prohibited and can result in immediate expulsion.

9. Violations

• Violating the course rules can lead to expulsion from the course and, at most, a partial refund (see § 8 (2) of our Terms and Conditions).
