Admission and German Language Requirements

Would you, too, like to receive a German higher education degree?

According to your foreign educational qualifications and certificates, we check if you are granted **direct or indirect admission** to a German institution of higher education.

Indirect admission means that you will have to take a two semester foundation course (Studienkolleg) and pass an assessment test before you can apply at a university.







Before you can begin your studies at a German university, you have to prove that your German language skills are sufficient.

For applications at the Studienkolleg an intermediate level – usually a completed B2 level – is required.

If you are granted **direct admission** a C1 level is necessary and your proficiency has to be confirmed by a successfully passed TestDaF (4x4 or better) or telc C1 Hochschule exam.


Study German at the Humboldt-Institut

At the Humboldt-Institut, we help international students to acquire the necessary German language skills fast and efficiently. Not only do we help you prepare for German language exams, but our schools are also licensed test centers for TestDaF and telc exams.

In our year-round schools in Berlin and Constance we teach 30 lessons per week in small classes with approx. 10 students.
